

Pople Ridge Farm Upcoming Information:

New York State Fair:

Pople Ridge will be attending the NYS Fair again this year. Please confirm with Deb if you are interested in going. The show runs from August 23-26. Marcia has entry forms and schedules. Or go to www.nysfair.org Click on competitions, scroll to horse show and download entry form and schedule. Everyone can mail their entries out themselves just indicate you are stabled with Pople Ridge. Entries are due August 8th.

Congress Information:

Congress Entries will be mailed on August 22nd. Marcia will need you to fill out your entry form and leave a **blank check**. (Do not make your check out to Congress, all checks must be made payable to Pople Ridge Farm) Marcia will give you a copy of your entry and check amount. A tack stall split will be included on your entry form. Marcia has extra entries in the office if you need to pick one up. Pople Ridge Farm is responsible for writing one blanket check for ALL stalls/entries, this is usually around \$12,000. Pople Ridge cannot cover your entry fees. If you forget to give Pople Ridge a check, your entry will not be mailed. Please get your entry form and check to Marcia by the deadline of August 22nd. Thank you.

ESQHA Fall Show:

September 20-23. Entries need to be post marked by September 5th. Go to www.esqha.org to download entry/schedule information. Everyone can mail their own entries, just indicate that you are stabled with Pople Ridge Farm.

Protocol for Veterinary Services:

Emergency situations (for example: lacerations, severe colic) North Country vet will be called immediately, then owner will be notified, then insurance company will be notified.(It is important we have current insurance information on file for your horse).

Other health situations (horse going off feed, small cuts/abrasions) Owner will be notified and owner will make the decision to call the vet or have Pople Ridge staff treat injury. If the owner is not able to be contacted, Pople Ridge Farm will call the vet if they feel it is necessary. Services that Pople Ridge Farm provide will be billed to each owner which may include things such as: medication given(bute, banimine, dex, etc) hand walking a horse, washing wounds, providing wraps.

If you would like health or emergency issues handled in a different way please put it in writing and give to Deb. Thank you.

Light Bulbs:

Pople Ridge Farm is asking boarders to supply light bulbs for your stall. If you notice your stall light is out, please buy a 100 watt bulb and leave it on your trunk and we will replace the old one. The light is very important for your horses coat.
