We are off to Rochester, NY and Frankfort, Kentucky this month.

Show Supplies everyone must have:

Everyone must buy your own grooming supplies: there will be a charge if you use Deb's.

- bricks
- fly spray
- show sheen
- kopertox,
- shampoos/conditioners
- cool pack
- spray paint
- hoof dressing

Other supplies needed

- Hunter Hack show pad
- regular white show pad
- hunter green schooling pad
- green sheet
- light weight blanket
- leather halter and lead
- wraps

A few reminders:

If you borrow my clippers, you must use your own blades.

The night before we leave for a show everyone must leave a halter and lead out as well as wraps.

If we launder your items, wraps, sheets, etc, there will be a charge.

Clean/polish/wash the following: trunks, saddle pads, tall boots/paddock boots, tack and tail extensions.

Hairnets must and riding gloves must always be worn when competing.

All supplies, bridles, pads, saddles, chaps, helmets, etc must be packed in equipment bags. Everyone going to Kentucky we need four separate checks: two for Entries, one for braiding, one for vet.
