Spring Vaccinations:

North Country Vet will be Vaccinating our horses again starting in March. Last year they made (2) farm calls, the first was for coggins & West Nile, the second for 4-way and potomic with rabies. Prices will be based on the same schedule this year. We will be collecting checks when we receive the prices from North Country Vet.

Feeding Treats:

For the safety of all horses, please do not feed treats to any horses except your own. Some of the biscuits and treats sold are large and difficult for some horses to chew. If you are feeding these to your own horse, use caution. Students in the lesson program: You may feed the lesson horses in the 9-stall only! Carrots or an occasional apple are acceptable treats, both of which must be cut up. Large carrots or apples of any size should never be fed whole.

Conditions of Stalls:

Boarders have the option of ordering stall mats for their horses stall. The price should be about \$100. This would reduce the amount of bedding needed. Sawdust has become scarce and expensive. We do not want to raise board, but we may have to if this trend continues. If you purchase mats, you will be saving money in the long run. Speak with Deb if you would like to purchase mats.

Blanket Season:

Blankets need to be kept clean for the health of you horse. When we have a break in the weather, please take the time to your wash your blankets and sheets. If you borrow one of Pople Ridge Farms blankets you must wash it before returning it. If we have to wash your blanket, you will be charged \$15.00.

Reminders:

Please shut the bathroom door completely when exiting, the heater is on this time of year. The door has been left open several times this winter causing the pipes to freeze.

Please do not touch the thermostat in the observation room. It should never be set over 65 degrees. It's not intended to be as warm as the tropics. There is no reason it needs to be set at 80 degrees for such a small room.
